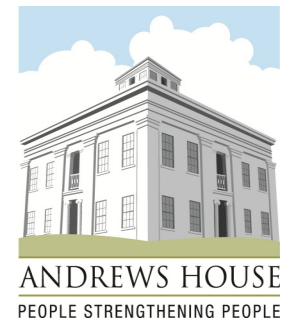
## Snapshot of Andrews House Services

- Mobile Market distributes fresh food and perishable items to more than 250 households twice a month. Approximately 1000 people per month benefit from this service.
- Summer Lunch Program serves 7200 lunches to low-income children at Woodward Elementary School including 2 backpack meals for the weekend.
- Legal Clinic serves nearly 300 clients per year.
- Kids on the Block puppeteer troupe performs to area elementary schools giving children the tools and the confidence to speak up about incidents of bullying and abuse.
- From 2006-2014 Andrews House was the home to the Grace Clinic Delaware, a free walk-in medical clinic serving persons without insurance. They have moved to a dedicated facility nearby at 40 S. Franklin St.
- AARP tax preparation services prepares 150 tax returns for seniors and low-income persons.
- *Second Fridays, Third Mondays & Third Thursdays* are free community meals that serve over 1400 delicious & nutritious dinners in a warm & welcoming environment.
- Supervised visitation services reunite non-custodial parents with their children.
- Six small non-profit help-giving agencies make Andrews House their home at below-market rental rates.
- Periodic free beginning computer classes.
- Small pantry helps people in immediate need of food.
- Provides 12-16 families with holiday meals at Thanksgiving and Christmas.
- Active in the Delaware County Hunger Alliance to raise awareness and promote collaboration to reduce food insecurity in Delaware County
- Serves as fiscal agent for the STEP program, a new program to address poverty in our community.
